

CHAPTER _____ SWIMMING POOL POLICY

In the past several years the Town of Hull has made a lump sum payment to the City of Stevens Point to cover usage of the municipal pool by town of Hull residents. It is proper to make such a payment because the City is providing a service that is actually being subsidized by the city taxpayers. The lump sum method of payment and the amount of that lump sum may not, however, be appropriate.

It is important to maintain a cost effective budget. The swimming pool fees paid to Stevens Point are part of the town of Hull budget.

In order to be cost effective and to allow for proper record keeping on swimming pool usage, the Town of Hull has initiated the following policy:

- 1) Town of Hull residents will be asked to purchase a SEASONAL POOL PASS from the city of Stevens Point.
- 2) Bring the Pool Pass to the Town of Hull office where it will be (photo copied and) submitted for reimbursement.
- 3) Town of Hull residents will be reimbursed for the cost difference between a resident (of Stevens Point) and a non-resident seasonal swimming pool pass.
- 4) Reimbursement will only be provided for Seasonal Pool passes and not for swimming lessons.
