

# How do I know which test(s) to perform?

There are 3 packages. You can choose to do any or all. The following information can be used to help you decide which to perform.

Package	What each package includes?	Which wells should be tested?
Homeowners \$49	Coliform Bacteria, Nitrate Chloride, Hardness, Alkalinity pH, Saturation Index	<b>All Wells:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is the basic package, perform this set of tests if you are unsure which package to perform.</li> <li>• Includes the two most important tests to Perform regularly on a well (bacteria &amp; Nitrate).</li> </ul>
Metals \$45	Arsenic, Lead, Copper, Iron, Zinc, Calcium, Magnesium, Manganese, Sodium, Potassium, Sulfate	<b>Consider this test package if:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You have never had your well tested for arsenic.</li> <li>• Previous tests indicated the presence of arsenic.</li> <li>• Your plumbing system has components that contains copper and/or lead.</li> </ul>
DACT Screen \$27	Test for a breakdown component of atrazine type pesticides.	<b>Consider this package if:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your well is within ¼ mile of agricultural fields where corn has been grown.</li> <li>• Previous tests indicated elevated nitrate levels that could be caused by fertilizer usage.</li> </ul>
